# I. CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL

### II. CONSENT CALENDAR

Lex Lauron moved, Marilyn Pimentel seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the consent calendar, which included the minutes from the November Board meeting

## III. REPORTS

Staff report - Director Teresa Robinson reported on enrollment efforts for next year and safety issues. (See Action Item D).

### IV. ACTION ITEMS

- A. Kermit Cuff move, Maria Sedano seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the hire of Fernando Yates to teach 8<sup>th</sup> grade math.
- B. Kermit Cuff moved, Marilyn Pimentel seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the first interim budget, which projects \$38,000 in excess revenues instead of the \$4,000 in originally adopted budget.
- C. Lex Lauron moved, Kermit Cuff seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve changes in the school's MOU with the County Office of Education:
  - a. That parents can always appeal an expulsion to the school board.
  - b. That in the event a lottery is needed for student enrollment and there's not enough space to enroll all applicants, that the school run the lottery in preference groups first taking in all siblings, then children of staff, then residents of the district, and finally, all the other applicants until there is no more room.
- D. For safety issues, Kermit Cuff moved, Lex Lauron seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to:
  - a. Require that staff never drive with a student alone unless in an emergency situation
  - b. Require after school staff to continue to call home by 4:15 p.m. all absences from the program (except for those not in school that day) and compile a list of which parents called for Board review
  - c. Postpone a decision on policy regarding students who are not picked up after dances, the after school program, etc.
